CIT104: Cybersecurity

This course provides students with basic information on how commonly encountered high-technology crimes are committed as well as basic investigation strategies including the collection of evidence and computer forensics focusing on the network. Crimes dealing with computers, telephones, checkreading machines, credit card machines and other technology are discussed. Issues dealing with jurisdiction and legislation to expressly criminalize cybercrime are discussed.
