Tuition Waivers

Tuition waivers cover the amount of tuition only, which is approximately 10% of the class price. Recipients are responsible for all remaining class fees.

If you are a Massachusetts resident you may be eligible for tuition waivers if you are:

- Sixty years of age or older
- A Native American
- A client of the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission or the Commission for the Blind
- An active duty service person
- A Veteran of the U. S. military
- An adopted or former foster child through the Department of Social Services (until age 24)
- A recipient of either the Adams Scholarship or the Stanley Koplik Certificate of Mastery for MCAS achievement
- A surviving child or spouse of the September 11, 2001 tragedy

Tuition waivers cover the amount of tuition only, which is approximately 10% of the class price. Recipients are responsible for all remaining class fees. Specific guidelines for waivers are described in the Categorical Tuition Waiver Application
